In May, 145 of you filled out a questionnaire and we learned a lot. We learned that a majority of those surveyed attend this church because of relationship, be it Sunday school, choir, or small group. We also learned that when it comes to matters in the church and the wider denomination, there are a lot of you who are unsure or uncertain about what is going on. However, when it comes to our hopes and dreams for the future, there is a great deal of certainty. In fact, the following words kept cropping up: growth, vitality, young people, growth, children, youth...oh, and growth! I too want this church to grow — in love of God and one another!

My vision for this church incorporates these hopes and dreams into a handful of numbers. Please hear me when I say, numbers are not how I evaluate you nor how I think God evaluates us. John Wesley believed that God regarded our hearts far more than anything else. But numbers help to know what we're shooting for and they help us shape the things we do.

My three goals for us are: 50-5-5. By May of 2023, I would like this church to have welcomed 50 new families/individuals into this church. In that same time, I am challenging every member to invite 5 people to church. And I would love to see 5 new professions of faith in Jesus.

Those are my goals. And those goals will help me preach, plan, and interact differently than I would have otherwise. Will you join me? Will you find ways to invite people to church? Will you invite people to join us on our mission in Newnan, GA? Will you find ways to love people with the love of our Lord Jesus Christ?

Lastly, in the stretch of exciting things that are happening in our church, I am overjoyed to welcome all of our new members who have joined in August: Diane Linehan, Stephanie and Cole Skinner, and daughter Margaret, Debbie and George Attwood, and Dan and Charlotte Scoggins. I pray that they would find in this church a warm and wonderful home that helps them become better disciples of Jesus Christ.
