Friends,

What a humbling experience it is to write to you today as the new lead pastor of Newnan First United Methodist Church. Adair and I are so thankful for your incredible kindness and generosity as we have adapted to a new life together in Newnan. We are grateful for the previous year of building relationships, working with an incredible staff, and worshiping on Sunday mornings.

I am also grateful to Charles who became Adair's and my first pastor together. His calm demeanor and prayerful care have been a wonderful and Spirit-filled guide for us in this time of transition. I am humbled to follow in his footsteps. If you haven't already, I hope you will send a note or express gratitude to Charles and Mickey for their years of loving ministry at this church.

The most humbling part of this journey is that we (you and me) stand on the shoulders of so many who have pastored and been pastored at this great church. Almost 200 years ago, 24-year-old Rev. W.W. Thank you so much for allowing us the use of your Parish hall to host the breakfasts for our IMPACT youth service event last week. It was a great setting to gather the youth teams, get them fed, and send them out to serve the community. The setup and support from NFUMC staff, Steve Webb and Aileen Burnett, could not have been better.

We had close to 150 youth and their adult leaders and they worked on projects such as:



- Framing a duplex home with Hope Global in the Chalk Level neighborhood that will house 2 families displaced by the March 2021 tornadoes.
- Painting the interior of the Cambridge House daycare center for adults with disabilities
- Building a dual wheelchair ramp at the Reece Center a horse therapy farm so kids in wheelchairs can be easily loaded and unloaded
- Working at Bridging the Gap and Coweta Pregnancy Service
- Cleaning up several lots that still have storm debris issues
- Painting the exterior of a house for a tornado survivor

WELCOME CONNOR BELL OUR NEW ASSOCIATE PASTOR

We reached out to Connor and asked him to provide us an introduction with a bio. We look forward to welcoming him to the Newnan First UMC staff on July 1, 2022.

I was born in Bay St. Louis, MS, a small town on the Mississippi Gulf Coast about an hour East of New Orleans. I have wonderful parents- my dad, Brehm, is a personal injury attorney with a heart for service at his church. My mom, Jenny, is a graphic designer who demonstrates grace and optimism in the face of any situation. I have three siblings: an older brother named Austin, a younger brother named Blake, and a younger sister named Daley. We all grew up together in the Bay (as it is affectionately called), famous for its small-town quirky charm, seafood, and being in the same county that Brett Favre was born in. We had a pretty quiet upbringing, and much of my life was tied to the United Methodist Church and the Mockingbird Cafe across the street, where I worked as a busboy from age 14 to 17. Yes, it is technically illegal to work at age 14. Don't tell the cops!



I attended the University of Southern Mississippi- the third-largest public university in Mississippi that is famous for such alumni as Brett Favre, Jimmy Buffet, and Afroman. I got my degree in English with an emphasis in creative writing. However, most of my time in undergrad was spent at our Campus ministry, the Wesley Foundation, where I served as a worship leader, participated in small groups and joyfully paid \$150 a month to live in a sizable closet upstairs. I also had a job as a Youth Group Intern at a United Methodist Church down the street and worked at camps and abroad during my summers. It was during college that I received my call into ministry and became a certified candidate in the United Methodist Church.

After graduating, I moved to Memphis, TN, and took classes part-time at Asbury Theological Seminary while I worked as a college minister. After Karolyne and I got married, we moved to Atlanta so that she could find a job, and I transferred to Candler School of Theology at Emory University where I received a

Masters of Divinity. I was commissioned as a Provisional Elder and served as an Associate Pastor at Glenn Memorial UMC, with about 70% of my role there being tied to the wonderful Youth Ministry. I was ordained in June of 2022 as an Elder in full connection.

I met Karolyne in undergrad and finally built up the courage to ask her out right before she graduated. It was the best decision I have ever made. Karolyne is driven, grace-filled has a great sense of humor, and was willing to be my sugar momma through seminary. We got married in July of 2016, which is when I began my classes at Candler. She has a Masters in Recreation Administration and works in the adaptive sports field at a paralympic sports organization in Atlanta, BlazeSports America.

A year after getting married, we got a dog! She is a Chinese Sharpei named Harper. Harper is a 50-lb. guard dog, and her hobbies include patrolling, barking, busting down doors to check on folks for no reason, putting a paw on your leg during dinner, and sleeping.

In April of 2021, we had our first daughter, Sophia. She is a redhead who currently knows 5 words and can walk up to 10 steps. She has turned our lives upside-down, and she has also brought so much joy and wonder into our

world. We give thanks to God for her every day.

I enjoy playing guitar and singing, riding my bike, running, playing with Sophie, and reading. I also love any team sport, and I have a secret competitive side that comes out if soccer or volleyball nets are in view.

I empathize deeply with Newnan's struggles after the recent tornado damage. In 2005, Hurricane Katrina devastated my hometown. Our house was flooded with 6 feet of water, and we had to move around and live with family for several months until we got a FEMA trailer that allowed us to live in our yard. So much of my personal call into ministry is connected to how I saw the Church be the hands and feet of Christ for my community during that time. I was proud to see the work that Newnan First has done to assist those affected by the tornado, and it reveals your character and faithfulness to a call of service in your community. I am looking forward to joining in with what God is already doing at Newnan First UMC!


