The theme for the exhibit is **"Journey through Faith"** and we are looking for submissions that resonate with concepts such as **Grace, Forgiveness, Light, Freedom, and the Spiritual Journey.**

If you have an existing piece or are inspired to create a new work that speaks to the theme, we would love to hear from you. We encourage you to let your talent guide you and share your unique creation with our community.

Thursday, September 10th.

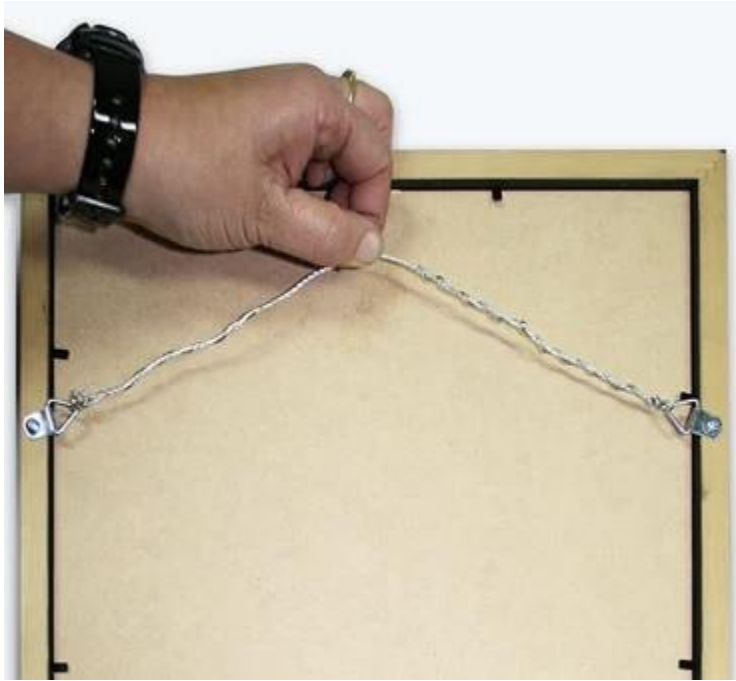

PLEASE follow the following directions for hanging!!!



Wire hangs 1/3 or 1/4 of the height down from top. Depends on the size of canvas.

Wrap wire around appropriate 'Eye Hooks'.

(Not clips; under pressure, they unsnap)

When wire is hanging on the hook, (see hand) wire should not be too tight, nor too loose.

Make sure the wire does not hang too close to the top of the frame. This keeps the Gallery Hook hidden behind the frame, instead of showing above the frame.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

AMO Gallery gives you the opportunity to sell your work if you wish. We do not participate in any transaction nor know the price of the artwork. We offer to have your contact information and the initials "FS" for sale or "NFS" not for sale, next to your name and email address. No pricing will be on display. Any person interested in purchasing your work can contact you directly to arrange the sale. We ask that if you sell your piece and need to pick it up before the exhibit's ending date, please work with us to coordinate the best time for the pickup.

The AMO Gallery is in a church building that is used all the time by members and visitors of the church. Our insurance coverage will not cover any loss or damage to your piece. You MUST agree to release Newnan First United Methodist Church from all liability associated with having your work displayed in this exhibit. By signing the form you also give us permission to use photographs of your work in our social media pages and on our church website.
