What a joy it was to celebrate Easter with so many of you. The entire holy week was beautiful, from our Maundy Thursday to our shared Good Friday at Mt. Olive UMC down the road. The Easter morning egg hunt was so awesome. The music and the choir were astounding!

To be honest, I'm sad that Easter is over. But I need not fear, for Easter is actually a whole season in the life of the church — a whole season remembering that God can turn the torture symbol of a Roman cross into a symbol for forgiveness, mercy, and salvation. And don't forget that God has also undone the power of the tomb, previously a symbol of death and finality. The tomb is now empty and a sign to us that death is defeated and will never again have the last word. Honestly, that question feels too big. Maybe there is a better way to ask that same question (but on a smaller and more personal scale). Try this – how can you help to show love and compassion just like Jesus? Or how about this – if you could do one thing to help make your neighbor's life better, what would it be? Or maybe – what talents and skills has God given you that you can use to assist God in helping another person you know?

The message is out. Easter has occurred. He's not in his tomb anymore. Jesus is loose! And he is fixing this world one healed heart at a time. Are you ready to join in? I pray that you are.






