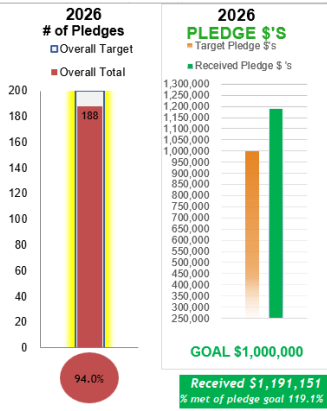
Children are a gift, please don't worry about wiggles or noise as they are signs of life and joy in our midst.

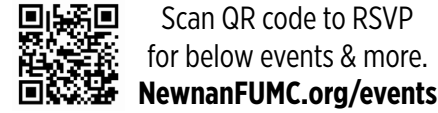
