

Last week, a Newnan FUMC church member left a note in my box. All it said was a quote from Max Lucado:

We all need the reminder: the heart of the human problem is the heart of the human.

When I called him later to ask why he thought to put that on a notecard and leave it for me, he mentioned that he had just felt moved by the Spirit in his devotional time. He shared that there is so much to think about and focus on in this world. Perhaps if we focus on the heart, we might get somewhere. Perhaps that is the call of the Christian. Perhaps that is the focus we should have. The heart.

In his sermon on January 22, Pastor Connor reminded us of what John Wesley said of the heart:

Every wise man, therefore, will allow others the same liberty of thinking which he desires they should allow him; and will no more insist on their embracing his opinions, than he would have them to insist on his embracing theirs. He bears with those who differ from him, and only asks him with whom he desires to unite in love that single question, "Is thy heart right, as my heart is with thy heart?" (The Catholic Spirit).

One of my professors in college used to say, "Everyone is doing the best they have with what they have to work with." I would dismiss his statement and immediately think of 10 people that weren't doing their best (sounds like I was more worried about a speck in your eye than the plank in my own). But his statement has stuck with me over the years, and the more I think about it, the more I understand what he was trying to say. His statement seems to me another way of giving others the benefit of the doubt. His statement seems in line with Wesley's concern for the heart.

The mission of the church is big. It is overwhelming. It is hard to wrap our brains around. And sometimes it seems foolish. But perhaps if we were to focus a little more on the heart of the individual, the call of the church in the world might feel more manageable.
